Our Gauteng tour offers the best of both worlds; from rugged game drives to top end hotel accommodation.

Johannesburg, South Africa's biggest city and capital of Gauteng province, began as a 19th-century gold-mining settlement.

We start the tour with a fishing session at Rust de Winter. From there we go to Mabula Game Lodge for an extraordinary encountering with South Africa's bushveld in the Malaria free Waterberg region of the Limpopo Province. Experience a game drive early morning in an open safari vehicle and celebrate in the sheer variety of animal, bird and plant life; the diverse landscapes ranging from grassland plains to rocky outcrops creating an ideal habitat for the free roaming Big Five and all the little creatures that contribute to a magical wildlife experience you'll never forget.

We return to Johannesburg and visit Montecasino. Montecasino is the premier entertainment destination in Gauteng. Their award-winning complex has been voted Best Casino, Best Entertainment Complex, Best Cinema Complex and Best Place to take out-of-towners.

We take a half day township tour of Soweto Township which was once home to Nelson Mandela and Desmond Tutu. Mandela's former residence is now the Mandela House museum.

We overnight at Emerald Resort & Casino situated on the lush banks of the Vaal River where you will fish the next day. The Vaal River is one of the best bass fishing venues in the country and a great challenge to any angler.

Gold Reef City is one of South Africa's top family attractions. It is an amusement park located on an old gold mine which closed in 1971. The park is themed around the gold rush that started in 1886 on the Witwatersrand. Descend down a 220m Gold Mine shaft with a guided underground tour and watch a 12.5kg gold pour.

The majestic Voortrekker Monument is a massive granite structure prominently located on a hilltop, and was raised to commemorate the pioneer history of Southern Africa and the Voortrekkers who left the Cape Colony between 1835 and 1854.

The following day we visit the Cradle of Humankind, one of eight World Heritage Sites in South Africa, renowned as the place where humankind originated. The area boasts thirteen excavation sites that are recognised as national heritage sites.

The Gauteng tour concludes with a visit to a Lesedi Cultural Village, one of the best tourist attractions in South Africa, allowing visitors to really explore the glorious diversity of the people of this land. Lesedi Cultural Village offers visitors a chance to encounter people of Zulu, Xhosa, Pedi, Ndebele and Basotho origin. You'll meet real people (not actors in fancy dress), enter their homes and listen to stories about their individual cultures and rituals of daily life. There's a craft market for last-minute curios and handmade local arts and crafts.

Mpumalanga is a province in eastern South Africa and top tourist destinations. It embraces the southern half of Kruger National Park which is a huge nature reserve with abundant wildlife including big game, magnificent scenery and great fishing venues.

Mpumalanga is considered to be one of the most geographically diverse and unbelievably beautiful places in South Africa.

In the northeast, the land rises towards mountain peaks and then terminates in an immense escarpment. In some places, this escarpment plunges hundreds of metres down to the low-lying area known as the Lowveld. The Lowveld enjoys a pleasant, generally frost free and sub-tropical climate.

On this tour you will be fishing an exclusive private venue over two days before we go on an excellent four day tour to the world famous Kruger National Park.

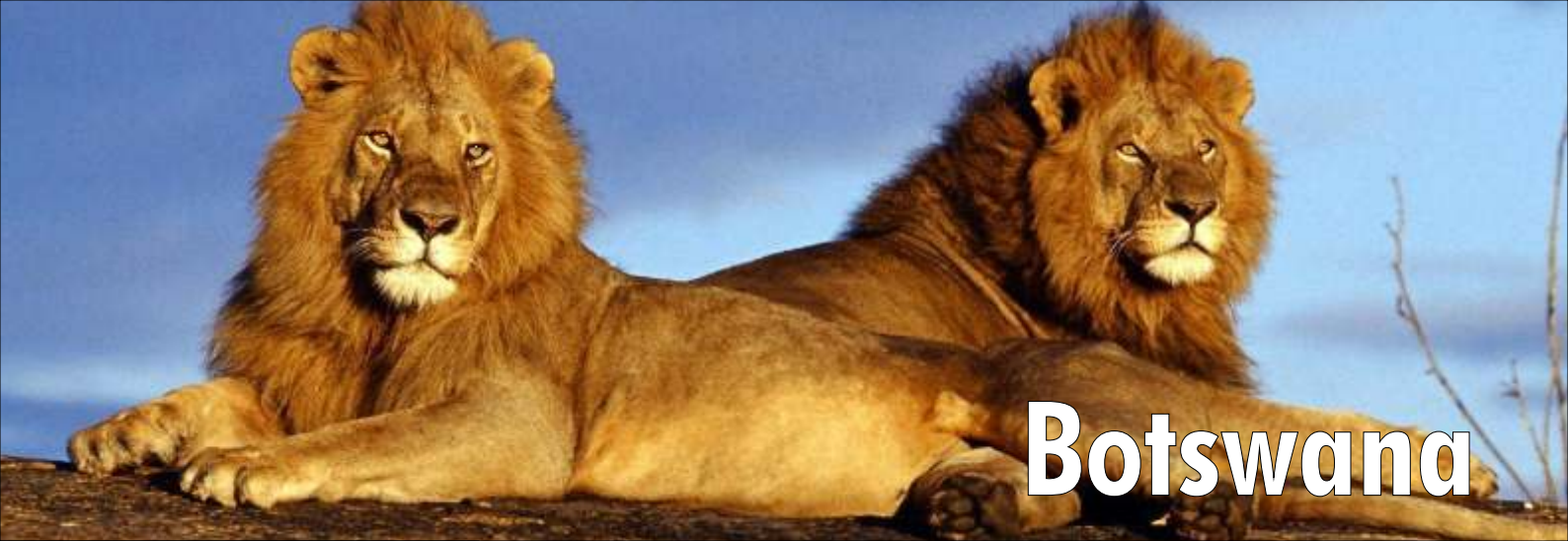
Kruger National Park, in northeastern South Africa, is one of Africa's largest game reserves. Its high density of wild animals includes the Big 5: lions, leopards, rhinos, elephants and buffalos. Hundreds of other mammals make their home here, as do diverse bird species such as vultures, eagles and storks. Mountains, bush plains and tropical forests are all part of the landscape.

We will go on game drives and look for Africa's Big Five on morning, afternoon, sunset and even a night game drive.

Our Botswana tour is recommended for the die-hard, totally bass fishing fanatic who is not interested in anything else. It is no fancy dress party. We use 4x4 vehicles to reach our fishing destination, but if you want to improve your PB then this tour is for you.

The tour starts at Casa Albergo guesthouse which portrays pure luxury, elegance and privacy. The guest house offers 5 air conditioned bedrooms, DStv (satellite TV) and stylish en-suite bathrooms. Also available are tea/coffee facilities, a bar, swimming pool that is surrounded by landscaped gardens.

Here you will be briefed on how to catch the lunkers waiting at Letsibogo in Botswana.

Botswana is a neighbouring country of South Africa and it hosts one of the ultimate bass fishing destinations; namely Letsibogo Dam. This trip includes three and a half days of just fishing.

On your way back to South Africa you will stay one night at Sun City, one of South Africa's world class venues. Sun City is one of Africa's premier vacation destinations. It is internationally recognized for its superb resort offering of hotels, attractions, shows, and world class events like the annual "Nedbank Golf Challenge." While you are there don't miss "The Palace of the Lost City" or the Valley of Waves.

Enjoy a day visit to Pilanesberg National Park, hosting Africa's Big Five. Situated in the ecologically rich transition zone between the Kalahari and the Lowveld, this vast area promises thrilling big game viewing in a malaria free environment.
