Our Gauteng tour offers the best of both worlds; from rugged game drives to top end hotel accommodation.

Johannesburg, South Africa's biggest city and capital of Gauteng province, began as a 19th-century gold-mining settlement.

We start the tour with a fishing session at Rust de Winter. From there we go to Mabula Game Lodge for an extraordinary encountering with South Africa's bushveld in the Malaria free Waterberg region of the Limpopo Province. Experience a game drive early morning in an open safari vehicle and celebrate in the sheer variety of animal, bird and plant life; the diverse landscapes ranging from grassland plains to rocky outcrops creating an ideal habitat for the free roaming Big Five and all the little creatures that contribute to a magical wildlife experience you'll never forget.

We return to Johannesburg and visit Montecasino. Montecasino is the premier entertainment destination in Gauteng. Their award-winning complex has been voted Best Casino, Best Entertainment Complex, Best Cinema Complex and Best Place to take out-of-towners.

We take a half day township tour of Soweto Township which was once home to Nelson Mandela and Desmond Tutu. Mandela's former residence is now the Mandela House museum.

We overnight at Emerald Resort & Casino situated on the lush banks of the Vaal River where you will fish the next day. The Vaal River is one of the best bass fishing venues in the country and a great challenge to any angler.

Gold Reef City is one of South Africa's top family attractions. It is an amusement park located on an old gold mine which closed in 1971. The park is themed around the gold rush that started in 1886 on the Witwatersrand. Descend down a 220m Gold Mine shaft with a guided underground tour and watch a 12.5kg gold pour.

The majestic Voortrekker Monument is a massive granite structure prominently located on a hilltop, and was raised to commemorate the pioneer history of Southern Africa and the Voortrekkers who left the Cape Colony between 1835 and 1854.

The following day we visit the Cradle of Humankind, one of eight World Heritage Sites in South Africa, renowned as the place where humankind originated. The area boasts thirteen excavation sites that are recognised as national heritage sites.

The Gauteng tour concludes with a visit to a Lesedi Cultural Village, one of the best tourist attractions in South Africa, allowing visitors to really explore the glorious diversity of the people of this land. Lesedi Cultural Village offers visitors a chance to encounter people of Zulu, Xhosa, Pedi, Ndebele and Basotho origin. You'll meet real people (not actors in fancy dress), enter their homes and listen to stories about their individual cultures and rituals of daily life. There's a craft market for last-minute curios and handmade local arts and crafts.
